SMS Terms of Service

Use of the Sunflower Circuit Clerk's Jury text message-based services (the "Service") is subject to the following Terms of Service. These terms constitute a legal agreement (the "Agreement"). Please read them carefully.

1. THE SUNFLOWER CIRCUIT CLERK will allow Jurors to opt-in by clicking on the opt-in option on the Juror Information form.
2. You can cancel the Service at any time. Just text "stop" or you may call (662) 887-1252 or email jms@sunflowercircuitclerk.com If you cancel texting notices you will be required to call a recorded message each evening for Jury Duty instructions
3. If at any time you have questions or need assistance, please call (662) 887-1252 or email jms@sunflowercircuitclerk.com
4. As always, message and data rates may apply for any messages sent to you from us and to us from you, and THE SUNFLOWER CIRCUIT CLERK is not liable for the cost of any such messages. You will receive recurring messages. If you have any questions about your text plan or data plan, it is best to contact your wireless provider
5. You understand that anyone with access to your mobile phone may be able to view the messages you receive when using the Service, and you agree that THE SUNFLOWER CIRCUIT CLERK will not be liable to you if this occurs.
6. You understand that you are not required to consent to the Service to perform your Jury Duties.
7. By agreeing to these Terms of Service and providing us with your mobile phone number when you opt in to the Service, you authorize THE SUNFLOWER CIRCUIT CLERK to contact you by text message at your mobile phone number using an automatic telephone dialing system or device, or any other computer assisted technology as applicable.
8. If you have any questions regarding privacy, please read our PRIVACY POLICY.
9. PRIVACY POLICY Your information will be used for official Sunflower County Circuit Court business as prescribed by law and will not be shared with any other third party or sold for any purpose. Upon completion of your Jury Service (typically 3 to 4 weeks) your information is deleted from our Jury Messaging System. You will only receive messages regarding your Jury Service duties (typically 3 to 5 messages).
